MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

THE UNITED NATIONS EDUCATIONAL, SCIENTIFIC AND CULTURAL ORGANIZATION OFFICE IN JAKARTA

AND

INDONESIAN JOURNALISTS' ASSOCIATION

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MoU") is entered by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization Office in Jakarta (hereinafter referred to as "UNESCO") and Indonesian Journalists' Association (PWI) (hereinafter referred to as "PWI"). UNESCO and PWI are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Parties".

WHEREAS the Parties recognize that they have shared visions and missions in the fields of the importance and strategic role of journalism school/training institute in advancing the quality and the professionalism of journalism in Indonesia;

WHEREAS the Parties particularly noted common interests in specific programmes and fields of activities such as broadening journalists' access to receive improvement in their knowledge and skills in the field of journalism which will strengthen their capacity in public empowerment through the provisions of information/news/current affairs and other type of journalistic products;

WHEREAS the Parties anticipate that an official and genuine partnership towards strategic co-operation in these programme fields, especially in the context of provision of courses materials and guest instructors which would bring benefits toward achieving the goals and objectives of the Parties for the people they serve; and;

WHEREAS the Parties have consulted with each other on such partnership and now wish to enter into a working relationship to pursue cooperation, in a synergistic and efficient manner.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties here to agree to cooperate as follows:

Article 1 Fields of Cooperation

- 1.1 Collaboration to strengthen journalism school(s)/training institute(s) established by PWI with local governments and/or other partners in Indonesia through various ways allowed by the rules and procedures of each party.
- 1.2 Joint provision of resources for promotion of the facilities provided under this cooperation so that they can be used optimally by the media communities.

Article 2 Responsibilities

- 2.1 UNESCO will assist in the development of training system of the journalism school/training institute, including provision of book(s) on journalism and/or short term/guest instructor(s).
- 2.2 PWI and its partners will provide the venue of the journalism school/training institute which will use the items provided by UNESCO as mentioned in para 2.1.
- 2.3 PWI will ensure the effective use and management of the school/training institute by the relevant media professionals it serves.
- 2.4 PWI will facilitate the use by PWI of UNESCO's book "Model Curricula for Journalism Education" as the basis in the development of curricula and teaching methods used in the journalism school/training institute, and will disseminate and share the content of the book to other relevant parties whenever possible
- 2.5 Modalities and technical arrangement for each possible joint activity, particularly concerning financial commitment, will be determined and guided by the governing bodies of both parties and their administrations on a case by case basis and separate additional agreements will be signed pursuant to PWI and UNESCO's rules and procedures. Although it is foreseen that there are possibilities for joint activities along the course of co-operation, there is no financial obligation whatsoever in this MoU for either party.
- 2.6 Relevant documents and publication materials produced in the course of this activity should include an acknowledgement section, which clearly states that the products were supported by UNESCO and should bear the logo of UNESCO.

Article 3 Other Arrangements

- 3.1 The Parties shall use their best efforts to settle amicably any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of this MoU or the breach, termination or invalidity thereof. Any dispute, controversy or claim between the Parties arising out of this MoU or the breach, termination or validity thereof, unless settled amicably under the preceding paragraph within sixty (60) days after receipt by one Party of the other Party's request for such amicable settlement, shall be settled by binding arbitration by a sole arbitrator appointed by mutual agreement, or failing this, by the Secretary-General of the Permanent Court of Arbitration pursuant to the Arbitration Rules of the United Nations Commission on International Trade Law (UNCITRAL).
- 3.2 Notwithstanding Article 2.6, unless authorized beforehand and in writing by UNESCO, PWI will not use UNESCO's name and/or logo for advertising, fund-raising, or any other commercial purposes.
