Subject: Agreement of Indonesia/UNESCO Trust Fund

Dear Mr. Hubert Gijzen,

Thank you for your continuous support on the cooperation and especially on the Agreement of Indonesia/UNESCO Trust Fund.

With reference to your letter dated 6 September 2013 regarding Agreement of Indonesia/UNESCO Trust Fund, we have sent UNESCO's suggestion to our legal at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MoFA) and we have received their review and the suggestion regarding article IV.8 as follows.

Article IV.8 as suggested by UNESCO: "UNESCO agrees to keep separate records with respect to funds provided to it by the Government. They will be accurate, complete, and up-to-date in respect to funds received and expenditures incurred with funds provided by the Government, and show that all disbursements are made in conformity with the intended purpose. UNESCO will maintain accurate records of funds provided by the Government under this Agreement."

Revised Article IV.8 as suggested by MoFA: "Keep separate records with respect to funds provided to it by the Government. They will be accurate, complete, and up-to-date in respect to funds received and expenditures incurred with funds provided by the Government, and show that all disbursements are made in conformity with the intended purpose. UNESCO will maintain accurate records of funds provided by the Government under this Agreement. Those records shall be made available to the Government at all times when it is deemed necessary."

In the Article VII.2 regarding Steering Committee, MoFA suggested to define clearly the person of his/her position to be the representatives from UNESCO instead of "At least four representatives of UNESCO". I send you herewith enclosed the latest revision of the Agreement of Indonesia/UNESCO Trust Fund for your reference.

Following the result of the communication between UNESCO Jakarta and the Minister of Education and Culture as well as Executive Chairman of Indonesian National Commission for UNESCO, it would be appreciated if the attached document can be reviewed and validated by UNESCO at the earliest convenience so that we can proceed the signing of the agreement shortly.
